- > Electronic timing, tested in 6 positions for accuracy
- > Replace dial and hands
- Re-case movement
- New seals
- ➢ Fit glass
- > Waterproof test as appropriate
- > Clean, refurbish and polish bracelet

- ⇔ A balance wheel makes 120 million revolutions every 9 months. The equivalent journey in a car would be 160,000 miles. In ten years that is the equivalent of 2 million miles. Source unknown
